

Can I take photos in the lockers

Can you take photos of people without permission?

Generally you can take photos of people when they are in public places like a park, or a beach, but cannot photograph them without permission when they are somewhere they have a reasonable expectation of privacy, like a bathroom, changing lockers at the pool and fitting rooms at clothing stores.

Can you take photos on public land?

Just because your feet are on public land doesn't mean that you can shoot into private property. If a person has a reasonable expectation of privacy in a location, even if it's public, you cannot take photos there. This includes public bathrooms and sports club locker rooms. It certainly includes private homes, including backyards and pool patios.

Can I take photos if I'm in a public place?

Generally, you can take any photos you want of people when they are in a public location, like a park, a beach or a city square. It's perfectly legal since they have elected to place themselves in a public location and have no reasonable expectation of privacy.

Can I take photos in the gallery?

You can take photos in the gallery unless it is stated otherwise. Photography must be for personal, non-commercial use only. The use of flash, camera supports and selfie sticks is not permitted. It is your responsibility to ensure copyright and other laws are not infringed. Filming requires prior permission.

Can I take a photo of my artwork?

Flash and tripods are not allowed but you can take photos of most of the artworks on display. Check the labels next to artworks which will indicate if photography is not permitted. If you aren't sure, staff in the exhibition rooms will be able to confirm this for you. Where can I eat and drink?

Can a person take a photo without their consent?

The taking of photographs of an individual without their consent is a civil matter. Taking a photo of a person where they can expect privacy (inside their home or garden) is likely to be a breach of privacy laws. The other issue to consider is what you plan to do with the photograph afterwards.

Breastfeeding is permitted in the Museum. Also, no food or drink is allowed in the galleries, but you can feed your kids in other areas (hallways and benches outside the galleries). Bags. Please do not bring large bags, backpacks, packages, or umbrellas into the galleries. Your belongings should be under 35 x 35 cm. Animals

You can access these spaces via Queen's Gate to the west of the Museum. There are also 12 Blue Badge parking spaces on Exhibition Road, which are managed by the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea and cannot be booked in advance. You can park there for four hours between 8.30-18.30.

As you can see from these photos, they have small size lockers (42 x 40 x 58 cm). I found that the small size was always big enough for my carry-on luggage. These are TWD 40 for three hours. They also have large size lockers (84 x 40 x 58 cm), which would be better for check-in sized luggage. These are TWD 60 per three hours.

Most of our lockers are open 24/7, but they can get busier during the week. Our top tip? Lockers tend to have more free space at weekends, so pop your parcel drop-offs into your Sunday life admin list.
