

# Can the storage USB drive be used to install the system

Do I need a USB drive to install Windows 11?

How do I run Windows 10 from a USB drive?

To boot into Ubuntu, make sure the USB drive is plugged in. If you want to use the OS on your hard drive (in other words, not the version of Ubuntu you just installed on the USB drive), remove the USB drive before rebooting. When the USB drive is disconnected, it will first try to boot from CD.
