How to install solar panels?

Make space for the solar panel accessories (solar inverter, cables and solar batteries, if desired), for instance in a plant room 4. Plan a day for installation 5. Erect the scaffolding (this can be done by your supplier or by a company you organise) 6. The solar panel mounts will be installed 7. The professionals will install the solar panels 8.

Where should a solar photovoltaic installation be installed?

The installation looks best when the panels run parallel to the edge that is nearest them, which is usually the eaves. We recognise that after performance, aesthetics are the most important aspect of a solar photovoltaic installation and so our installation teams will ensure this to be the case.

Should solar panels be tilted?

Installing solar panels completely flat, or even at very low tilts, should be avoided, as this increases soiling losses. When solar panels are tilted, the rain can be quite effective at cleaning panels as it hits them and rolls off. If a panel is flat, the water will pool on the surface, and even at low tilts water can collect along the frame.

Can solar panels be mounted on a flat roof?
