Step 2 - Remove The Screws Holding The Fixed Panel In Place And Then Pull Out One Side Of The Panel After removing these screws, it should be quite easy to slide out one side of a panel. You may want to tap gently on the end of the door fixed panel so that it will not scratch your floor or walls before removing one side of a sliding door fixed panel.

They are usually fixed to the roof with screws or clips. You will need to remove the screws or clips using a screwdriver or pliers. Once the rails are removed, you can take the panels down one by one.
