If stripping the sill back to bare concrete use a paint stripper to help remove the old paint. If there is any algae or fungi ingrained in the sill, use a suitable fungicidal wash to wipe away and leave to dry. Step three: Fill and sand sill. When refreshing a window sill prior to painting, it often needs filling to give it a smooth finish.

The most important step in the window-replacement process happens long before installation day. It's when you measure the window dimensions of the existing window frame to make sure you order a replacement unit that's the right size. Here's how to do it. Start by measuring the inside width of the old window frame, jamb to jamb, in three places--across the top, middle, and bottom.
