Where should Jinko Solar PV modules be installed?

In most applications, Jinko solar PV modules should be installed in a location where they can receive maximum sunlight throughout the year. In the Northern Hemisphere, the module should typically face south, and in the Southern Hemisphere, the modules should typically face north.

Don't lift up PV modules using the attached cables or the junction box. All PV systems must be grounded.

What should you not do with Jinko Solar?

Do not apply excessive force or objects on the surface of the module, do not impact, and do not twist the frame of the module, which may damage the cells or cause the cells to crack. Do not use the module to replace or partly replace roofs and walls of buildings. Do not remove any part installed by Jinko Solar or disassemble the module.
