Are roof mounted PV systems a hazard?

Common property hazards to be assessed when considering the installation of roof mounted PV systems include: PV systems introduce new electrical components such as wiring, invertors, control equipment as well as the PV panels themselves. These components can be subject to failure, damage, or heating, increasing the risk of fire.

Can PV panels be installed on a new roof?

Where PV panels are to be installed on an existing roof, consideration should be given to the extra weight they will add. If you are planning to install panels on a new roof as part of a new build or reinstatement, it is important to be aware of the different risk implications of different roof types (e.g. flat vs pitched).

Can a PV system damage a roof?

Roof damage can result from excessive load of snow/rainwater combined with the weight of the PV system. PV systems can move in the event of seismic activity resulting in damage and the potential for fire. The installation of a PV system can introduce new components which may increase the likelihood or severity of a loss.

What should I consider before installing a solar roof?

Prior to installation, it is important to assess the roof's age, load-bearing capacity and very importantly the combustibility of the roof material and any insulation. A Freedom of Information request made last year has found a 12% increase in fires sparked by solar panels last year, compared to 2020.

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If you plan to install solar on a flat roof then be aware of potential pitfalls and extra costs, as it's likely you'll want the panels mounted on adjustable frames. This will allow you to position the panels at the optimum angle

The solar panels need to be spaced out more, so they don't overshadow each other which means they take up more space compared to a solar panel system on a sloped roof.
