How to build a solar cooker?

You can build a solar cooker with simple, affordable materials like cardboard boxes and aluminum foil. There are different types of solar cookers: panel, box, and parabolic, each suited to various cooking needs. Customizations such as insulation and reflector adjustments can greatly improve your solar cooker's efficiency.

How do I make a solar cooker box?

To create the box, measure out 4 sides onto your wood planks. You can make your cooker square or rectangle; it's entirely up to you. The size of our box is 12" x 12". Using these dimensions, measure and cut the base of your solar cooker. Lastly, the height of your box will depend on the size of your pot. Our box is 7" in height.

How do you make a solar cooker stand?

To make the stand, cut a thin piece of dowel which you can use to prop the flap up. To determine the length of your stand, measure the highest angle you'd position the flap; this is the length between the front corner of the solar cooker and the back corner of the top flap.

Steps To Make a Solar Cooker. Step-1. Fold the top pads closed on the larger box and place the inner box on top and drop a line everywhere it onto the top of the larger box. Remove the smaller box & cut end to end to make a hole in the top of the larger box. Maintain 1 inch space between these two boxes.
