What is a solar installation safe work method statement (SWMS)?

This Method Statement for Solar Panel addresses the hazards and controls involved with solar panel installation on a roof. The purpose of this Solar Installation Safe Work Method Statement (SWMS) is to describe the sequential approach for the installation of PV Modules in accordance with the contract requirements.

What is a mains-connected PV installation?

A mains-connected PV installation generates electricity synchronised with the electricity supply. Installers are obliged to liaise with the relevant Distribution Network Operator (DNO) in the following manner: 30 days. Multiple installation covered by G83/1 - application to proceed (G83/1 appendix 2).

How should a PV system be designed & installed?

From the outset, the designer and installer of a PV system must consider the potential hazards carefully, and systematically devise methods to minimise the risks. This will include both mitigating potential hazards present during and after the installation phase.

Can a PV system be electrically installed?

Guidance exists for electrical installation of PV systems[15,16,17]but there is little equivalent guidance for mechanical installation.
