

Photovoltaic panels installed on the roof of the vineyard

The product and installation cost of solar panels to power a shed will be minimal in comparison to digging up the garden to install reinforced cables run from the mains. The installation process typically takes several days to complete, depending on the size of the system and the complexity of the installation.
