Is it legal to fit a washing machine in a bathroom?

Is it legal to fit a washing machine in the bathroom? It's not strictly illegal to have a washing machine in a bathroom but, due to building regulations in the UK, you do need to consider how and where it's installed. Plug sockets are typically not fitted in bathrooms in the UK, with the exception of shaver sockets.

Can you put a washing machine in a bathroom in the UK?

It is legal to put a washing machine in a bathroom in the UK as long as you follow certain rules. Mainly the machine cannot be plugged into a standard wall socket. You'll need to get a fused connection unit installed by an electrician. Plus the machine cannot be any closer than 3 metres from the bath, sink or shower.

Can you use a washing machine in a bathroom?

The main criteria is that a person in the bath or shower (and presumably even on the toilet) should NOT be able to touch the washing machine. The washing machine should also be plugged in outside the bathroom and protected by an RCD. If you must install a washing machine in a bathroom, seek out and consult the official regulations.

How far away should a washing machine be from a bathroom?

One of the main reasons for this is that plug sockets need to be at least three metres away from your bath or shower. Therefore, most bathrooms and shower rooms in the UK don't have the space to be able to fit a washing machine far enough away from the bath and/or shower.
