Building regulations approval is mandatory for solar panel installations in the UK. The approval process ensures compliance with safety, structural, and electrical standards. It verifies that the installation is carried out by competent installers and that all relevant regulations are adhered to.

When will solar panels be mandatory?

In March 2024, the European Parliament approved a law requiring solar panels on all new residential buildings by 2030. The EU Solar Standard makes it mandatory for member states to gradually include solar installations in new public, commercial, and residential buildings.

Are solar panels a legal requirement for new homes?

Even though installing solar panels on new builds is a great way to set new homes up with renewable energy from day one, it's not yet a legal requirement. One common problem is that developers don't use all the available roof space, resulting in a less effective solar panel system.

You should know that there are limitations for series solar panel wiring. In the U.S., solar strings are required to feature a maximum voltage of 600V, so solar arrays comply with article 690 section 7 of the National Electrical Code (NEC 690.7).

1. Solar panel costs are too expensive. Solar panels aren't cheap, but their price has dropped dramatically over the past decade. They can be less expensive than other renewable technology, such as heat pumps, and achieve greater energy bill savings.

To produce 1,000kWh per month, you would need a large solar panel system of at least 12kW or more which is likely to require 16+ panels.
